Indianapolis Associate Board of Ambassadors Overview

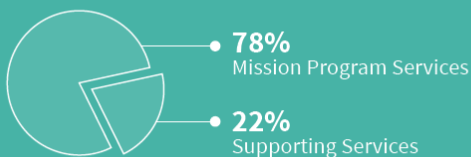

Indianapolis Associate Board of Ambassadors Membership Requirements

The Indianapolis Associate Board of Ambassadors membership begins on January 1 and ends on December 31. As a member of the Indianapolis Associate Board of Ambassadors, individuals must complete the following:

Fundraise a minimum of \$1,000

Register on ABOA personal fundraising site

Become or recruit at least one ACS CAN Member

- **Total fundraising minimum of \$1,000.** An ABOA member can meet this requirement by fundraising in the following ways: personal fundraising site, event sponsorship, ticket sales, or third-party fundraisers. A third-party fundraiser could be a golf outing, jeans day, can drive, give back night at restaurant, bar crawl, etc.
- **Attend & Assist with ABOA/ACS related events.** These events include:
 - Monthly ABOA Meetings/Calls
 - ABOA Events: Circle City Soiree , Networking Events, and more
 - Volunteer at additional ACS Events: Discovery Ball, Indy Select Golf Outing, Lobby Day, etc.
- Register on ABOA personal fundraising website
- Become or recruit at least one ACS CAN member: Cost = \$10 per member
 - The American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network is the nonprofit, nonpartisan advocacy affiliate of the American Cancer Society.
 - ACS CAN members receive the Action Taker Toolkit & early access to ACS CAN's annual reports
